**Must be registered and have I.D. Number or cannot Enter**

Entry Fee: \$.75 per Class per Entry

LIMITATIONS: Any boy or girl 18 years of age and under, residing in Sangamon and surrounding counties.

Entries Close: By mail must be postmarked by midnight, **Friday, June 6, 2008**; online by midnight, **June 6, 2008**; or in office by 4:00 p.m., **Saturday, June 7, 2008**. Entry fees and exhibitor ticket fee must accompany entry blank.

- All rabbits to be delivered to the Superintendent of Department not later than 8:00 a.m., **Wednesday, June 18, 2008**. Judging at 9:00 a.m., **Wednesday, June 18, 2008**. All rabbits not in place at that time will not be judged and no refund of entry fee will be given.
- Each exhibitor must be present at time of showing.
- Rabbits will be released after show.
- Rabbits must be entered in the name of the actual owner who shall also be a breeder of the variety shown.
- Rabbits entered in the single classes cannot compete for pen prizes, nor rabbits entered in the pen classes for single prizes.
- The American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc., guide-book and standard shall be the guide to judging rabbits.
- All rabbits entered must be permanently earmarked with India Ink, and tattooed.
- **Each exhibitor limited to two (2) entries under any one lot number.**
- Carrying cases are to be furnished by exhibitor.
- The Association is not liable for any loss or injury.
- Exhibitors must carry own exhibits to judges table.
