- All exhibits must be in place by 9:00 a.m. **Tuesday, June 17, 2008.** All exhibits not in place at that time will not be judged and no refund of entry fee will be given. Judging will begin at 9:30 a.m., **Tuesday, June 17, 2008.**
- **Exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries under any one lot number except where otherwise specified.**
- Exhibit tags and claim checks should be picked up in the Fair Office. Exhibit tags must be on your exhibits or they will not be judged.
- Entries will be released **Sunday, June 22, 2008** between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Exhibits left after 4:00 p.m. will be at owners risk as no Superintendent will be on duty after this time.
- All flowers must be grown by the exhibitor except those used in arrangements or otherwise specified. These may be acquired, but work must be done by the exhibitor. **ALL DISPLAYING AND ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE DONE BY THE EXHIBITOR WITH NO ASSISTANCE.**
- Exhibitor must furnish containers.
- The Association will not be responsible for flowers or containers at any time.

A - ANNUAL FLOWERS - Display in a jar

LOT#

- 1 - Cut Single petunia, 6 stems
- 2 - Cut Double petunia, 6 stems
- 3 - Marigolds (large), 6 stems
- 4 - Marigolds (dwarf), mixed variety, 6 stems
- 5 - Zinnias (large), any type, 6 stems
- 6 - Snap Dragons, 6 stems
- 7 - Any flowers other than listed, annual, 3 stems

B - PERENNIALS

- 1 - Any Kind, Perennial, 5 stems
- 2 - Baby's-Breath, 3 stems (not to exceed 18" in height)
- 3 - Lily (Any Species) 1 stem
- 4 - Roses, 1 variety, 3 blooms, properly named
- 5 - Roses, mixed variety, 3 blooms, properly named
- 6 - Rose, specimen, 1 bloom, properly named

C - BOUQUETS

- 1 - Sweet Peas, Hardy (minimum of 6 stems)
- 2 - Nasturtium
- 3 - Mixed Bouquet

D - POTTED PLANTS - Single Plant in Pot

- 1 - Coleus, any variety or color
- 2 - Begonia, Flowering

- 3 - Begonia, Tuberous, rooted
- 4 - African Violet, single bloom, single crown
- 5 - African Violet, double bloom, single crown
- 6 - Cactus or Succulent (please attach name)
- 7 - Jade Plant
- 8 - Geraniums

E - FERNS - Any size pot - for plants in pot in excess of 12" exhibitor must furnish own stand

- 1 - Fern, Asparagus
- 2 - Fern, Boston
- 3 - Fern, All others

F - HANGING PLANT DISPLAYS

- 1 - Philodendron and Pathos
- 2 - Any type Fern
- 3 - Spider or Airplane Plant
- 4 - Ivy, any type
- 5 - Impatiens
- 6 - Any other kind hanging plant

Hanging plants exhibited must have been in the possession of the exhibitor at least 3 months. No plant shine may be used.

G- CUTTINGS

- 1 - One Single Cutting, any variety - must have cutting date and planting date.
Not to exceed 1 year old after planting date.

H - ARRANGEMENTS - No artificial or silk flowers in arrangements unless specified.

- 1 - "Blue Skies/Starry Night", using blue and white flowers.
- 2 - "Summer Camp", Cheerleading, music, basketball, volleyball, etc.
- 3 - "4-H", using all green plant material.
- 4 - "Farmer in the Dell", arrangement using a farm container and all dried material.
- 5 - "The Queen of Hearts", arrangement using red and pink flowers.
- 6 - "Mirror, Mirror ". A mirror as background for Silk flower arrangement.
- 7 - "Mothers Day Breakfast Tray", Including tray, cloth and dishes, 24" wide space, no food or flatware.
- 8 - "Primary School", arrangement of all primary colors, red, yellow, blue
- 9 - "That 70's Show", arrangement with a 1970's era theme.
- 10-"Luck of the Irish", arrangement of green, white and gold.
- 11-"Down by the Shore", sea shells with dried material.
- 12-"My Future Occupation", an arrangement theme for fireman, astronaut, teacher, shoe salesman, fast food worker, etc.
- 13-"Nursery Rhymes", suggesting favorite nursery rhyme, place title with arrangement.
- 14-"Disney Movie" – miniature arrangement using fresh material- not to exceed 6" in any dimension.
