All exhibits must be in place by 9:00 a.m. **Tuesday, June 17, 2008** or entries will not be judged and no refund of entry fee will be given.

- **Exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries under any one lot number except where otherwise specified.** Exhibit tags should be picked up in the Fair Office. Please have exhibit tags on your exhibits or they will not be judged.
- Judging will begin at 9:30 a.m., **Tuesday, June 17, 2008**.
- **All flowers must be grown by exhibitor except those used in arrangements or otherwise specified.** These may be acquired, but work must be done by the exhibitor.
- **ALL DISPLAYING AND ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE DONE BY THE EXHIBITOR WITH NO ASSISTANCE.**
- Exhibitor must furnish containers.
- The Association will not be responsible for flowers or containers at any time.
- Entries will be released **Sunday, June 22, 2008** between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Exhibits left after 4:00 p.m. will be at owners risk as no Superintendent will be on duty after this time.

A – ANNUAL FLOWERS - Display in a Jar

LOT #

- 1 - Single petunia, 6 stems
- 2 - Double petunia, 6 stems
- 3 - Marigolds (large), 5 stems
- 4 - Marigolds (dwarf), mixed variety, 6 stems
- 5 - Lily – (Any Species) 1 Stem
- 6 - Zinnias (miniature, not over 1 1/2" in diameter), 5 stems
- 7 - Any other flower not listed

B - ROSES - HYBRID TEA - Rose properly named

- 1 - Red, 1 bloom
- 2 - White, 1 bloom
- 3 - Yellow, 1 bloom
- 4 - Blue, 1 bloom
- 5 - Pink, 1 bloom
- 6 - Orange, 1 bloom
- 7 - Any other Kind, 1 bloom

C - BOUQUETS

- 1 - Mixed Bouquet
- 2 - Sweet Peas, Hardy (minimum of 6 stems)
- 3 - Perennial, any kind, 6 stems

D - POTTED PLANTS - Single Plant in Pot not to exceed 8"

- 1 - Coleus, any variety or color
- 2 - Begonia, Flowering
- 3 - Begonia, Tuberous, rooted

- 4 - African Violet, single bloom, single crown
- 5 - African Violet, double bloom
- 6 - Cactus or Succulent (please attach name)
- 7 - Jade Plant
- 8 - Geraniums

E – FERNS

- Any size pot - for plants in pot in excess of 12" exhibitor must furnish own stand.
 - 1 - Fern, Asparagus
 - 2 - Fern, Boston
 - 3 - Fern, All others

F - HANGING PLANT DISPLAYS

- Hanging plants exhibited must have been in the possession of the exhibitor at least 3 months. No plant shine may be used.
 - 1 – Philodendron and Pathos
 - 2 - Any type Fern
 - 3 - Spider or Airplane Plant
 - 4 - Ivy, any type
 - 5 - Impatiens
 - 6 - Any other kind

G - CUTTINGS

- 1 - One Single Cutting, any variety - must have cutting date and planting date. Not to exceed 1 year old after planting.

H – ARRANGEMENTS

- No artificial or silk flowers in arrangements.
- **Anyone who has arranged flowers part time or professionally will not be allowed to show in Class H - Arrangements. (A Professional is anyone who has been self-employed or works for a florist.)**

- 1 - "Country Kitchen", using whole fruit and/or vegetables and flowers in kitchen utensil
- 2 - "I'm Lost", miniature arrangement using fresh material - not to exceed 6" in any dimension
- 3 - "Something Old - Something New", using natural dried and fresh material
- 4 - "Sing Along", arrangement suggesting any song title, place name of title with arrangement
- 5 - "County Fair", arrangement - exhibitor's choice. No artificial.
- 6 - "Teacher's Desk", exhibitor's choice, not to exceed 8"x8"
- 7 - "My Inspiration", cut flowers only - exhibitor's choice
- 8 - "Green Fields", arrangement of all green plant material
- 9 - "Country Roads", arrangement of dried wayside material- no preservatives added
- 10-"Withered Away", arrangement of dried material - preservative may be used
- 11-"My Day Will Come", arrangement of fresh and dried plant material
- 12-"This Land Is Your Land", a patriotic arrangement predominantly of reds, white, and blues incorporating fresh flowers, fruits and/or vegetables in the design
- 13-"Terrarium", dish garden or sand sculpture - a living design in a glass container - not to exceed 20". Must be work of exhibitor.
- 14-"Holiday Motif"-Exhibitor's Choice
- 15-"Wall Hanging", arrangement of dried material-preservatives may be used. **(no artificial)**

I – TABLE SETTINGS

- Arrangement will be judged on its appearance from ALL sides, using one place setting on tablecloth or placemat.
- Accessories permitted, space furnished is a 24 inch square table.
- No paper plates, silverware or food permitted.
- Floral arrangements can be fresh, dried materials, artificial fruit or silk flowers.
- **Must** have floral arrangement in table setting.
