- Exhibits released **Monday, June 15, 2026 between 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.**
- Most entries need to be mounted on matte or poster board with a 1" or 2" margin. (Exceptions include batik, sculpture, pottery or certain paintings on canvas.) **PLEASE NO FRAMES!**
- The Sangamon County Fair and the Superintendents of this fair will take all reasonable precautions to protect the entries but will not be responsible if loss or damage should occur.
- **Each exhibitor is limited to one (1) entry under any one lot number.**
- **IMPORTANT NOTICE:** All entries must be completely original and the work of the exhibitor and must have been made since July 1, 2025 or have not been exhibited previously at the Sangamon County Fair. Please do not submit paintings or drawings that have been copied from another artist's work.
- Exhibit tags and claim checks will be mailed to exhibitor - please have the exhibit tags on your exhibits or they will not be judged.
